Well-being

Goal -

 To foster student well-being through the creation of positive, safe and inclusive learning environments.

Priority:

 Support social, emotional, mental, physical and spiritual wellness among students through positive relationships and the creation of equitable, safe, accessible and inclusive learning environments.

Strategies:

- Educators and teachers (Pre-primary to Grade 12) will foster positive and effective classroom environments, promote authentic voice and choice, build meaningful relationships, establish, and teach predictable routines, and create environments in which students see themselves reflected through culturally responsive and universally designed practices.
- Inclusive Education Lead Teams (P-12) and Regional Programs staff will continually monitor data, including disaggregated data, to measure impact and adjust school and regional strategies in well-being, literacy, and numeracy, through a multi-tiered system of supports.
- Regional staff will foster a positive understanding of anti-racism education in Grades 8 to 12.
- Regional staff will model and promote staff wellness strategies.

Literacy

Goal -

 To improve student achievement in literacy.

Priorities:

- Focus on guided, small group instruction at all grade levels and in all content areas
- Focus on a balance of daily writing, reading, and speaking and listening at all grade levels and in all content areas.

Strategies:

- Regional staff and Teaching Support
 Teams in Grades Primary to 12 will
 support all teachers to incorporate
 literacy activities at all grade levels and in
 all content areas.
- Regional technology and Programs staff will promote and support the use of digital literacy tools including, but not limited to, SORA, Raz Kids, Boreal Tales, Google Read and Write and EPIC.
- Teachers in Grades Primary to 12 will implement a balance of individual, small and whole group instruction in all subject areas
- Schools and teachers in Grades Primary to 12 will promote and celebrate daily authentic writing across all content areas.

Numeracy

Goal -

 To improve student achievement in mathematics.

Priorities:

- Increase student achievement in mathematics with a focus on number sense activities at Pre-primary to Grade 12 using high impact strategies.
- Increase student achievement in mathematics with a focus on analysis level questions at Grades Primary to 12.

Strategies:

- Regional programs staff will support schools in Increasing the capacity of Teaching Support Teams and Learning Support Teachers to be able to provide Tier 2 and Tier 3 mathematics support.
- Teachers will utilize play-based and inquiry-based strategies, value real world experiences, and promote thinking in mathematics.
- Teachers will use guided math and small group instruction strategies to support student learning.
- The use of Knowledgehook will be promoted and supported with classroom teachers and Learning Support Teachers.
